Recent Open Doors: As we come to the close of another year, we wanted to take a moment to reflect on God's incredible provision and the many doors of opportunity He has opened for our family in ministry. We are so grateful for your unwavering prayers, support, and partnership, which have been a constant source of encouragement throughout 2024.

This year, we had a full schedule of ministry, both at home and abroad. After being required to leave Honduras for paperwork purposes early in the year, we spent a short time in Washington, where we were blessed with opportunities to participate in church ministries, visit supporting churches, and continue sharing about the work in Honduras.

This year's International Pastors' Training Conference in July was a major focus. Months of preparation went into making this event as impactful as possible, from property repairs and landscaping to securing materials for the pastors. Through the Sponsora-Pastor Project, over 100 pastors were sponsored, and we were able to provide over 200 pastors with Bibles, teaching materials, and life-changing sessions which were an encouragement to the pastors. Through the conference, there was a sweet spirit of gratitude, and we sincerely believe that God was glorified throughout.

As we entered the third quarter of the year, we continued to be involved in various local ministries, including outreach efforts with the law enforcement and presidential military. We also made significant progress on our property, including the construction in our dining hall, improvements to our Internet system, and landscaping development.

As the holidays rolled around, we began our furlough in Washington to focus on raising additional support and moving my mother up to Washington. We also continued our Spanish language studies and were highly involved in the ministry here at Faith with several large back-to-back events, including our missions conference, the Mexico pastor's conference, and Preacher's Delight.

Looking ahead, we are excited about the future and the many opportunities that God has in store for us. We are especially encouraged by the new partnerships being formed and the ongoing work in Honduras. As we prepare for the upcoming year, we ask that you continue to pray with us for God's will for the ongoing residency process (which continues to force us out of the country every three months) and for continued open doors to nshare the gospel and minister to God's people. Thank you again for your faithful partnership and prayers. We are continually humbled by God's faithfulness and look forward to what God will accomplish in 2025!
